PROJECT NAME: EUROPEAN MARITIME DAY (EMD) IN MY COUNTRY

Description:

The European Maritime Day (EMD) Conference is the annual two-day event during which the European maritime community comes together to network, discuss and forge joint action on maritime affairs and the sustainable blue economy. **STATE:** ON-GOING **LANGUAGE:** SPANISH /ENGLISH

PERIOD: MAY 17 - 21ST

Since the organization of this conference, which this year will be held in Den Helder (Holland), professionals, companies, governments, public institutions, NGOs and the academic world are invited to replicate events at a local, regional and national level. We have presented the following proposal to the European call, to which we incorporate activities that we have already carried out in the previous call:

- **Yincana Virtual Blue and Safe Tourism** The PC game developed by Lab COEPA researchers, its associated entities and collaborating institutions, consists of individually performing 10 online tests in a maximum of 50 minutes through a digital tour of some of the most significant enclaves of the city, which put in value the coastal tourist resources, as well as the business network related to the sea, emphasizing the environmental commitment and the prevention of risks on the Cadiz coast.
- **ConservAcción game for beach cleaning** The educational game for PC (Spanish/English) of low difficulty is recommended for all ages and has been developed by two of our external collaborators with the aim of raising public awareness of the importance of keeping the beaches and ocean clean in a city. playful way; since the sea constitutes an essential part of our ecosystem and a very important source for tourism.
- **Promote the Decalogue of the Ocean** The objective is to promote individual and collective commitment, especially of young people, at a personal and institutional level for the conservation of the seas and to encourage actions for the promotion of citizen science.

Objective


To give the population of cities knowledge about urban ecosystems to promote their use to improve human well-being.

PROJECT NAME: GUIDE FOR RESILIENT AND SUSTAINABLE CITIES

Description:

The project consists of creating a guide of good practices in sustainability and risk management for urban areas. The guide will be divided into five sections:



LANGUAGE: ENGLISH/ SPANISH/PORTUGUESE/ RUSSIAN

PERIOD: SECOND SEMESTER OF 2021

- Urban ecosystem services and their importance for human well-being.
- Ecosystem-based management for urban areas.
- Risk management for urban areas.
- Communication for civil society.
- Implementation of the concept in local governments.

Objective

To create a guide for sustainable and resilient cities aim to the improvement of the citizen's well-being.

How can the Eurasian People assembly collaborate?

The Eurasian People assembly can finance the creation and publication of the guide. It will also disseminate and promote the guide through the Eurasian region. The Laboratory will create the guide in Spanish, and the Eurasian People assembly can collaborate with the translation of the guide to any language it deems necessary. The laboratory will be willing to participate in workshops or any other activity to promote the guide after its completion.
